


Joshua M. Jansa – Summary of Teaching Evaluations


Figure 1 is a dot chart displaying students' average overall rating of the instructor for each course I've taught as sole instructor since 2014. Students were asked to rate the instructor overall on a 5-point scale. Each course is labeled with the year, short title (see course summaries above for more information), and institution. The red line denotes the mean rating across courses. I have consistently been rated as a strong instructor by students, with a mean score of 4.77/5.00.

I have also improved courses as I've taught them multiple times. Figure 2 shows the overall instructor and course ratings for Intro to American Government (in person) over time. The course enrolls about 140 students per semester. Students were asked to rate the instructor and course overall on a 5-point scale.

*Out of 4.00. The OSU Student Survey of Instruction (SSI), administered online, has a four-point scale. The Department of Political Science in-person instructor surveys have a five-point scale. SSI was used for this course since it was an online class.
